Definitions:

Isolation

Isolation is for a sick individual.

Isolation includes:

1. 10 days of self-isolation and at least 1 day fever-free (*without use of fever reducing medications*).
2. Isolated individuals must stay away from others, even in their own home.
3. Return to school/work if symptoms have significantly improved.

All 3 of the above conditions must be met before isolation is lifted.

Quarantine

Quarantine is the process a community member must follow when he/she someone comes into close contact with a COVID-19 Positive person.

Following exposure to a known COVID-19 Positive individual, community members must quarantine for 14 days. During this time, they must:

1. Check temperature two (2) times per day.
2. Monitoring for symptoms of COVID-19, which may include: Fever or chills, Cough, Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, Fatigue, Muscle or body aches, Headache, New loss of taste or smell, Sore throat, Congestion or runny nose, Nausea or vomiting, Diarrhea

NOTE: Horizon Science Academy Springfield cannot disclose specific case information due to FERPA/HIPAA laws.

As of the time of the report, the population distribution at Horizon Science Academy Springfield is as follows:

- 99 students (26% of the population) currently enrolled in the hybrid program, which includes face-to-face instruction. (*Currently only offered to students in grades K-3*)
- 279 students (74% of the population) currently enrolled in the distance learning program.
